Eligibility

1. Candidate for this scholarship must be a woman who has applied for admission to Hawaii Community College or is a current Hawaii Community College student.
2. Applicant must enroll in a Hawaii Community College degree program that is eligible to be transferred to a four year degree educational institution.
3. She must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.8 and be enrolling in a full course load (12 credits or more) for the scholarship year.
4. She must demonstrate financial need to the Hawaii Community College Financial Aid Office

Application Deadline

All components of the completed application must be postmarked by April 1st, 2019.

## Application Procedure

1. Complete the application form
2. Order the transcripts from the most recent educational institution you have attended and submit them along with your complete application form. Transcripts will be sealed by the records office
3. Ask the two people you listed as references to complete their recommendations and send or give them to you in a sealed envelope. Ask your references to sign across the seal.
