INSTRUCTIONS.

- 1. From your browser window, save or export this document as a PDF onto your device. It is a fillable PDF form which you can edit. You must also have the free <u>Acrobat Reader</u> or similar PDF reader on your personal computer or laptop device. Email the completed form (as a PDF attachment) to: <u>hiloelaine@gmail.com</u>. Any problems with this process, please email hiloelaine@gmail.com.
- 2. Order **official** college transcripts from all colleges you have attended. Have the transcripts sent to you. Transcripts will be sealed by the college records office and you must leave the seal intact.
- 3. Ask the two people you listed as references in this application to complete their recommendations and mail or give them to you in a sealed envelope. Ask your references to sign the envelope across the seal to ensure that it is intact when we receive it.
- 4. Mail your transcripts and recommendation letters to:

We will consider only completed applications, which consists of your emailed application form, and one separately mailed envelope containing unopened college transcripts and two unopened letters of recommendation; all must be postmarked by May 1.

ELIGIBILITY.

- 1. You must be a woman eligible for in state tuition.
- 2. And, you must be enrolled in a baccalaureate degree or post-baccalaureate degree/certificate program at UHH and must have at least a junior status (60 or more credits) by the start of the Fall 2022 semester.
- 3. And, you must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 and be taking a full course load (12 credits or more per semester) during this academic year (Fall 2021– Spring 2022).
- 4. And, you must demonstrate financial need by having submitted a financial aid application to UHH.
